

Boarding

DOS

- DO make sure that your dog is up to date on all vaccinations. If you are unsure about what shots you need feel free to give us a call.
- DO bring ONLY enough food/medication to cover your dog's entire stay. PLUS an extra day's worth of meals/medicine, just in case you can't make your scheduled pick-up day. Any leftover food or medicine will be returned to you.
- DO bring your pet's food in a labeled zip lock or container.
- DO bring a labeled article of clothing that "smells" like you to keep in your dog's kennel. You could also bring a favorite blanket or toy. This will help comfort your dog while you are away. Please realize that your dog may soil or chew this item, so please bring something you do not mind parting with. (Idea: Wear an old t-shirt to bed the night before your dog arrives!)
- DO make sure your dog arrives with a buckle or snap collar with current ID and rabies tags attached to wear while staying with us.
- DO book all future appointments via our website with your own personal account.

DONT'S

- DO NOT bring your dog's food and water bowls from home. Dog Care Plus will provide clean bowls for your dog's use.
- DO NOT bring a pinch and/or chain collar for your dog's stay.
- DO NOT worry about your dog as they will be having a great time playing with their pals.

Daycare

DOS

- DO make sure to drop off/pick up your pet between 7:00AM-7:00PM.
- DO bring your dog in on a leash with a flat nylon or leather buckle or snap collar with a current ID and rabies tag.
- DO make sure that your dog is up to date on all vaccinations. If you are unsure about what shots you need feel free to give us a call.
- DO bring a lunch or snack for your dog, if you would like, in a labeled bag. (Idea: Bring it in a brown paper bag so we can recycle it at the end of the day.)
- DO be sure in the warm weather months of April – September to have your dog on a flea & tick preventative.
- DO make sure to keep your emergency number updated with us.
- DO inform us of any other people who may be picking up your pet and have them bring in a photo ID when picking up.

DON'TS

- DO NOT bring any pinch and/or chain collars in as they tend to slip off or loose links while your dog is playing.
- DO NOT bring your pet's food in any container that you would like to have back.
